GREEN TECH & STEM CAREERS EVENT

WHAT: A hands-on demonstration event to educate students about green technologies and inspire them to consider STEM careers.

For two hours, students in grades 4-6 will be engaged in hands-on rotating demonstrations in green technologies and related careers. Presenters will be leading technology experts from Greater Cincinnati companies and organizations.

Activities include:

1. Learning how to measure watt meters to determine the amount of electricity a device uses and how to apply this information to assess energy efficiency
2. Learning how we measure and monitor air quality with equipment that detects volatile organic compounds and particulate matter
3. Learning the basics of fuel cell and solar technology, demonstrated by assembling toy cars powered by these technologies
4. Learning how architects and lighting experts measure light in foot candles in order to recommend proper lighting within buildings.
